## 1847: A Grand Year

---

*an homage to our inauguration, these hand-crafted cocktails highlight historical events throughout our favorite year*

1847

*dettling alabama bourbon, grand hotel estate honey-mint syrup, fresh lemon | 14*

**1847:** F.H. Chamberlain began construction of the hotel. The hotel was originally a two-story building containing 40 guest rooms and a shaded gallery that overlooked brilliant views of Mobile Bay.

## Walker, Texas Ranger

*dread river rye whiskey, cinnamon & coffee infused averna amaro, angostura bitters | 18*

**January 4:** Capt. Samuel Hamilton Walker of the Texas Rangers teamed up with Samuel Colt to produce the Colt Walker Revolver— a partnership that saved the Colt reputation and forged their names in history.

## Ghost of Banquo

*buchanan's pineapple, ghost tequila, sherry, pandan syrup, angostura bitters, absinthe mist | 16*

**March 17,** "L'opera senza amore!" Verdi's tenth opera *Macbeth*, premieres in Florence. After his untimely death at the behest of Macbeth, Banquo returns in the form of a ghost, seen only by the guilty conscience of Macbeth himself.

## The Exmouth

*the botanist islay gin, aperol, fresh grapefruit and lime, champagne sage reduction, prosecco | 14*

**April 25:** The Exmouth, a British whaling ship turned emigrant transport, wrecked against the south side of the Isle of Islay; all but three of the 244 souls aboard succumbed to the icy waters of the North Atlantic.

## Grit & Glory

*bulleit rye, honey jalapeño syrup, luxardo syrup, angostura and orange bitters* | 15

**September 14:** General Scott and the US Marines captured and raised the American flag over Mexico City-- an event memorialized in the Marine Corps hymn with the line "from the halls of Montezuma".

## Dracula's Lament

*corralejo silver tequila, fresh lemon syrup, maple blackberry sage reduction, orange bitters, applewood smoke* | 15

**November 8:** Abraham "Bram" Stoker was born. We hope you enjoy this bloody good cocktail inspired by his most notorious gothic horror novel, "Dracula".

## The Sisters Brontë

*vanilla-infused ketel one vodka, kahlua, espresso, salted caramel sweet cream cold foam* | 19

**1847:** was an exciting year for sisters Emily, Anne and Charlotte, all submitting manuscripts for publication; Wuthering Heights, Agnes Grey, and Jane Eyre.

## Dark Horse

*goslings black seal rum, fernet-branca, passion fruit, fresh lime, blackberries, ginger ale* | 15

**1847:** James Knox Polk was POTUS, often referred to as the first "Dark Horse" president. His most notable achievement, however controversial, was the acquisition of the southwest territory of the United States from Texas to California.

## North Star

*lemon-infused vermouth, strawberry simple, fresh lemon and mint, ginger beer* | 12

**December 3:** Fredrick Douglass publishes the first issue of his newspaper, "North Star". The motto of the newspaper was: "Right is of no sex—Truth is of no color—God is the Father of us all, and we are brethren".

## Not-So-Old-Fashioned

---

In the early 1800's a "cocktail" was made up of the following ingredients: **spirit, sugar, water, bitters.** As the years passed and drinks evolved, bartenders and patrons began referring to the original recipe as the "old fashioned" way of preparing a cocktail. Here is our take on a few— some old, some new.

### The Old Fashioned Way

*booker's bourbon\*, demerara sugar cube, water, angostura bitters, served neat— the old fashioned way* | 30

### Smoked Old Fashioned

*woodford reserve bourbon, turbinado syrup, angostura & peychaud's bitters, applewood smoke* | 22

### Banana's Foster Old Fashioned

*banana and vanilla bean-infused rum, pecan liqueur, maple syrup, orange and angostura bitters* | 18

### Bacon Old Fashioned

*bill e's bacon fat washed bulleit bourbon, montenegro amaro, Korean orange cheong, angostura bitters, maple-bacon lardon* | 24

### French Old Fashioned

*beefeater gin, lemon-infused dry vermouth, champagne sage syrup, angostura bitters* | 16

### Tequila Old Fashioned

*1800 reposado, crème de cacao, agave nectar, orange bitters, orange blossom water spritz* | 16

### Maggie's Farm

*hibiscus and mint-infused vodka, osmanthus and butterfly pea flower-infused simple syrup, crème de violette, fresh lemon, egg white | 16*

### Linda

*cachaca, st-germain, estate grown lemongrass and mint, fresh lime, strawberry reduction, soda | 14*
